Wed 8 March, 2–5pm

Location: Torrens River bus tour and Botanic Gardens walk. Participants will be split into two groups and experience 1 hour in each location. Meet outside the entrance of the Sanctuary (AWP organised transport leaves at 2pm sharp - 10 mins travel).
